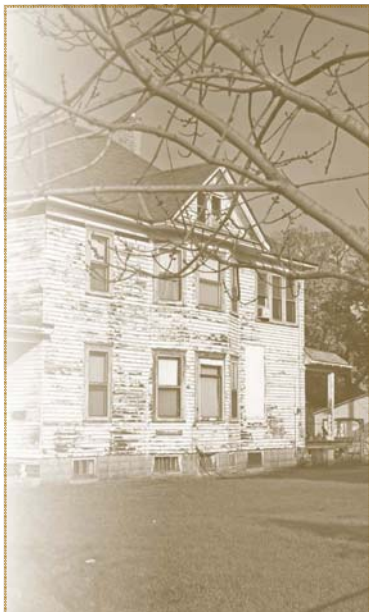
I am renting my apartment. Do I qualify for this program? Yes, if...

- ▶ You have children under the age of 6 and they get a blood lead test before work begins.
- ▶ You have children under the age of 6 who regularly spend time in your home (e.g., child care).
- ▶ You meet the income guidelines to participate in the program*. See chart bottom right.
- ▶ Your landlord is willing to participate under the requirements of the program.

I own my own home. Do I qualify for this program? Yes, if...

- ▶ Your house was built before 1978.
- ▶ You have children under the age of 6 and they get a blood lead test before work begins.
- ▶ You have children under the age of 6 who regularly spend time in your home (e.g., child care).
- ▶ You meet the income guidelines to participate in the program*. See chart bottom right.
- ▶ You are willing to participate under the requirements of the program.

*Income levels differ by size of family.

Lead hurts kids! It can interfere with your child's brain development and cause learning disabilities and other health and behavior problems.

You may qualify to get 75% of the cost of the work done on your home for **FREE**.
